Tuition

The following sections show a systematic process for enrolling home school students and providing services to them throughout their school career. In these sections, you will learn more about the home school extension program and its benefits for students, and their families.

Enrollment

With few exceptions, home school students, traditional school students, and their families will follow the same enrollment procedure. If someone needs the complete student file, this procedure will assure it is available. Exceptions may include medical forms, athletic forms or travel permission forms for home school students who will not be participating in any on-campus activities.



The school should receive all records from previous schools in order to determine a student's appropriate grade level. Such records may not be available if parents teach a student at home. In such cases, the person responsible for enrollment at our school will work together with the parents, in order to determine his or her grade level. The parents can accomplish this in a variety of ways.

Often home school parents keep "unofficial" records of courses their children have completed, as well as the grades they have earned. Home school parents may transfer this information to the official records of our school. Determination of appropriate grade level, courses completed, and accumulation of earned school credits is especially important for high school students who plan to fulfill the requirements for high school graduation.
